Ginoza Village was born on April 1, 1946, with the four settlements of Kochiya, Ginoza, Sokei and Kanna divided from the former Kin Town. In the years during the post-war confusion, with the rich natural environment of abundant water sources and fertile soil, the village developed mainly with agriculture, and in recent years the declaration of "organic village Ginoza" based on a safe and secure agricultural produce, through production and branding of strawberries. Furthermore, as a landmark on the east coast, Ginoza Road Station has also been greatly remodeled and developed. Ginoza Village prides its comfortable natural environment and culture.
